

GW Open Zone Entry Form

- **\$130** New Bowlers (includes bowlers who have not played for at least 5 years). This also includes bowlers under the age of 19 who wish to play the zone round only

Entry Deadline is Tuesday, January 23, 2024 by 5:00pm

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All C5PBA rules will govern this tournament.
2. This championship is open to all bowlers over nineteen (19) years of age as of December 31 of the current bowling season. Bowlers UNDER the age of 19 are eligible to bowl the zone round if desired, but ARE NOT eligible to qualify for a team. Bowlers under the age of 19 will pay only the cost of lineage for 20 games.
3. Bowlers who advance to the provincial and/or national rounds MUST HAVE A VALID C5PBA MEMBERSHIP, as of December 31 of the current bowling season, in order to qualify for funding. Any non-affiliated bowlers will be responsible for ALL accrued travel, accommodation and lineage costs.
4. An Entry Form is attached. Submit the form with applicable fees (cash, credit vouchers, cheques or e-transfer made payable to "Regina 5-Pin Bowlers' Association or R5PBA"). **NOTE: NSF cheques will result in a surcharge and automatic disqualification.**
5. **Dress code:** All bowlers shall wear appropriate apparel as there may be a potential bowling sponsor attending the event. No denim, sweatpants, caps or shirts advertising profanity, offensive language, liquor products, etc. If a bowler is not wearing appropriate apparel (at the discretion of the tournament officials) he/she may be disqualified
6. All decisions by the Tournament Chairperson (or Special Events Coordinator) are final.
7. Zone Roll-off (scratch): 10 games on Saturday **PLUS** 10 games on Sunday. Total pinfall for 20 games.
8. In the event of a tie for the 3rd, 6th, or final qualifying positions, a one (1) game roll-off shall be held to determine the final placing.
9. The top nine (9) men and the top nine (9) women (based on total pinfall) will advance to **Provincial Championships in Saskatoon from March 28 – 30, 2024**

10. The top three (3) men and the top three (3) women will bowl in the Provincial Singles competition. These bowlers will also bowl in the Men's and Women's team events.
11. All qualifiers advancing to the Provincial Championships must be prepared to:
 - a) Pay an assessment of **\$250** per bowler and **\$100** per coach; which can be offset by credit vouchers.
 - b) Sell two (2) books of raffle tickets or pay \$40 per unsold book
 - c) Receive one Regina Zone shirt at 40% of the full cost. Any additional shirts will be available at 100% of the cost.
12. All qualifiers advancing to the **National Championships in Ottawa, Ontario on May 28 – June 2, 2024** must be prepared to:
 - a) Participate, sell tickets, attend and volunteer their time to assist in the SINGO fundraiser (April 27, 2024) to raise funds for our national qualified bowlers
 - b) Pay an assessment (bowlers & coaches); which is determined by the S5PBA. Regina qualifiers will be required to pay an assessment of 40% of Regina package cost towards their expenses. Credit vouchers can also be used to offset the cost of this assessment.
13. Bowlers who earn a spot on a Regina zone team and withdraw from advancing to Provincials or Nationals, without a valid reason, are subject to automatic suspension from further participation in the Saskatchewan Open Championships unless and until that suspension is successfully appealed (C5PBA Format General Rule #4).
14. All coaches, once chosen for an "Open" team, cannot compete in the Provincial or National Championships during the current season.
15. The tournament committee reserves the right to complete the field and all decisions by the committee will be final (C5PBA Format General Rule #7).
16. All bowlers must bowl in the Zone where they reside, unless they declare otherwise as per S5PBA and must hold a current C5PBA membership card.
